Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

Happy New Year! You may not believe this, but the next few months will fly by! Soon it will be spring, we will begin state testing, and, yes, we will be making plans for summer. I am a huge proponent of finishing strong. Please know that your children will be working and learning right up until the end of the school year. As we begin the second half of the school year, here are a few friendly reminders:

Attendance and arriving on time are important. Even though I allow extra time for late arrivals on days when the weather is bad, we have a large number of students arriving late each day. This disrupts learning for your child and their classmates. Students who are missing school are missing instruction and learning. Moreover, our schools are marked down by the state for excessive absences. Coming to school each day, when there is no illness present, is an expectation.

Homework is important. It provides students with practice and, even more important, allows teachers to assess learning and guide instruction.

Encourage your child to ask for help when needed. Your child may need extra academic support. If you see them struggling with assignments, ask them to reach out to their teachers, or feel free to contact your child's teacher yourself. Many teachers offer extra help at lunch and/or throughout the day. Your child may also need behavioral support. Talk to your child regarding their feelings at school, and be sure to encourage them to ask for assistance if they need it.

Remember to keep the school informed. Let us know of any changes at home. A new baby in the house or a relative that is ill can impact how a child behaves or performs.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of the Demarest families who participated in our recent Martin Luther King Day of Service. We have two beautiful murals, a newly decorated restroom, and a bright and cheerful cafeteria thanks to your efforts.
